Board of Director's Monthly Meeting Update

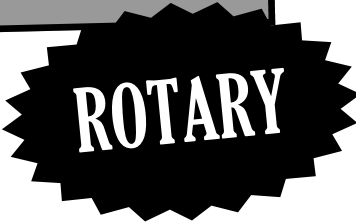
- Attendance for December was 74.2% with YTD at 71.0%.
