9 Structured Programs and 9 Service Opportunities help clubs achieve service goals in their communities and ones abroad, fostering goodwill and fellowship in the process. Disaster Relief, as a service opportunity dates from 1913 when clubs responded to flooding in the midwest. By issuing a "notice of disaster", a district governor can identify a means for which Rotarians can contribute to relief efforts. Another way to help a stricken area is to develop an international service project.

September Meeting Updates...

Sept 3: Brian Hartke, an Evansville resident employed by Bristol-Myers Squibb discussed his opinions about prescription drug relief as part of Medicare, protecting Retirement Benefits through a strong Social Security system and controlling businesses.

Sept 10: Lloyd Benjamin, United Way Campaign director said the pilot resulted in 20% of the total goal. More than 91 cents of every dollar goes to local UW programs. UW was a main agency in collection and distribution of relief funds for 9-11. Let's support UW!

Sept 17: Ron Green, Dean of ISU Business School said there are 1300 Business majors at ISU and there is need for intership and class project opportunities. Eli Lilly just awarded large grant to the School of Busi-

ness. He has plans to revitalize the MBA program and looks forward to a day when a new facility will be built.

Sept 24: Rotary district Governor Mary Ann Cunningham and husband, past district Governor Bill spoke about Rotary International Campaign to eradicate polio. Only 10 countries still have the wild polio strain. "Fulfilling the Promise" is the goal to raise US\$80 million to eradicate polio by 2005. Plans to celebrate the success of this 25 year effort will be celebrated at the 100th anniversary of Rotary to be held in Chicago. To help with the \$80M, **TH Rotary Club donated \$12,000** with \$1K from the Happy Jar and a check presentation of \$11K to District Governor Mary Ann.

- A new Rotary Club is forming. The Warrick County club will meet at Rolling Hills Country Club.

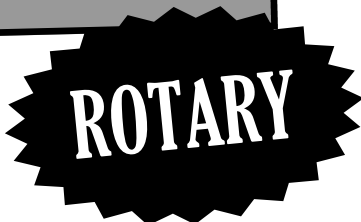
